December 12, 2005 was not a very good day for me. It all started when I checked the newspaper obituaries that morning only to find that a dear friend, Bill Hanford, had passed away at the age of 93. For those of you who may not have known him, Bill was a Taconic TU member for over 25 years. He never missed any events, be it the Frigid Frolics (our ice fishing events), the Conroy's Castle (summer picnics), the BCLS banquets, or whatever. He was a reliable acid rain monitoring volunteer for years, who teamed up with member Ed Desaulniers.

He was an active member of the board of the Friends of the Williams River. That, you may recall, was the group which was formed in the 1980's, when the Taconic Chapter partnered with the Lenox Garden Club and "adopted" the Williams River through the Riverways Adopt-a Stream Program. He was a member of the R.O.M.E.O's (Retired Old Men Eating Out) and missed few luncheons until his health began to fail him. He was an honorary member of the Board of the Taconic Chapter.

After putting down the newspaper, I opened my e-mails and had more disturbing news that morning from Berkshire County League of Sportsmen (BCLS) president, Mark Jester. Tom Keefe, DFW Western Wildlife District Supervisor had passed away. Tom was another personal friend who I would see at the monthly BCLS meetings, the HVA meetings, the ACEC meetings, and others. He worked hard on getting year round boat access for fishermen onto Lake Garfield. He was a great help in providing me info for the Berkshire Eagle Outdoor Sports column. You may recall that Tom received the BCLS Sportsmen's Appreciation Award for "going well beyond the call of duty to represent the interests of district sportsmen and conservationists."

That evening, I clicked on the e-mails again and there was a message from Joe Overlock, President of the Berkshire County Fly Fishers, with more bad news. Ernest Schwiebert, famous flyfishing author had passed away at age 74. To quote fellow author Dick Talleur, "Ernie was arguably the most brilliant mind the flyfishing world has ever seen." He wrote such books as *Matching the Hatch*, *Nymphs*, and *A River for Christmas*. Some of our senior TU members may recall seeing him at the Council Banquet in Northampton in 1983. At that event, I met him, conversed and got his autograph in a couple of my books. Although I did not personally know him, he wrote a very nice message. Still, I knew him well enough to be saddened by his loss.

After that, I clicked off the computer and went to bed. You know, some days are just not worth getting out of bed.
